

Recognize the signs of an opioid overdose:

- ✓ Small, constricted "pinpoint pupils"
- √ Falling asleep or loss of consciousness
- ✓ Slow, shallow breathing
- ✓ Choking or gurgling sounds
- ✓ Limp body
- ✓ Pale, blue, or cold skin.

What to do if you think someone may be overdosing:

- 1. Call 911 immediately
- 2. Administer Narcan®, if available*
- 3. Try to keep the person awake and breathing
- 4. Lay the person on their side to prevent choking
- 5. Stay with him or her until emergency workers arrive

Overdose Reversal: Narcan® (Naloxone) nasal spray may be obtained from any pharmacy, no order needed. Cost may be covered by insurance or cash pay with a discount card.

Opioid Abuse Risk Factors

Overlapping prescriptions from multiple providers and pharmacies



Taking high daily dosage of prescription opioid pain relievers



Family history of alcohol/ substance abuse



History of severe depression or anxiety
